**Your Surgery**

My aim is for you to experience as little pain and discomfort as possible during and after the procedure. I will be conducting a pre-anaesthetic consultation prior to your surgery. At that time there will be an opportunity to discuss any matters of concern. As I may be in theatre when you call, a message will be taken, and I will contact you as soon as I am available.

Please be reassured that Australian anaesthetists have world class training in anaesthesia, pain control, resuscitation, intensive care and managing medical emergencies, so there is no safer place in the world to have an anaesthetic than in Australia.

**My Professional History**

Following completion of my medical degree at Monash University in 1994, I was appointed to the resident staff at the Alfred Hospital for three years before commencing five years of specialist training, also through the Alfred.

My fellowship was completed at The Alfred and The Royal Children's Hospitals. I received my specialist qualification from the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists in 2004 and have been practicing for 20 years as a specialist in Melbourne. My practice takes me to The Alfred, Cabrini, St Vincent's Private and St John of God Healthcare networks, amongst other hospitals, where I am active as a general anaesthetist and also in Obstetrics and Paediatrics.

## **FEES FOR ANAESTHETIC SERVICES – Dr Ian Lack**

The fee for your anaesthetic is billed separately, generally a pre-payment is required and is in addition to Mr Yap's fees and any hospital charges.

### **Patients with Private Health Insurance**

Depending upon the operation, the insurer and your level of cover, "out-of-pocket" expenses can vary along with the way fees can be processed. Where applicable, your fund may be billed direct to contribute to the costs of my fees. Please note that this is not permitted by all funds or available for all procedures. Where this is not applicable, my office will bill you direct and issue you with a receipt after your fees have been paid. You may then be able to claim a portion of the fee from Medicare and your private health fund.

### **Patients without Private Health Insurance**

Patients without private medical insurance are required to prepay the total fee no later than five business days prior to their procedure.
